SCHEME FOR ISSUE OF HEALTH CERTIFICATE FOR PRODUCTS EXPORTED TO TURKEY

1. INTRODUCTION:

Republic of Turkey introduced a Regulation (No.25216 dated 1.9.2003) thereby establishing the requirement of Health Certification for products imported into Turkey and designated Export Inspection Council and its Branch offices as the authorised agencies for issue of Health Certificates for such products exported from India to Turkey.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

Unless the context otherwise requires:

- 1. "Council" means the Export Inspection Council of India established under section 3 of Export (Quality Control & Inspection) Act 1963 (22 of 1963);
- 2. "Agency" or "EIA" means anyone of the Export Inspection Agencies established at Chennai, Delhi, Kochi, Kolkata and Mumbai under section 7 of the Act;
- 3. "Branch office" means any of the Sub-Offices working under the jurisdiction of an EIA;
- 4. "Product" means any of the food products or food packaging materials covered by the above- mentioned Turkish Regulation.

3. BASIS OF ISSUANCE OF HEALTH CERTIFICATE

Health Certificate will be issued for consignments which conform to Turkish requirements/buyers' requirements/ relevant National standards as applicable. Checking of compliance would be possible under any of the three systems of inspection and certification as per details given under 4.

4. **PROCEDURE FOR CHECKING COMPLIANCE**

4.1 CONSIGNMENT WISE INSPECTION (CWI) SYSTEM

4.1.1. General:

Under the consignment wise inspection (CWI) system, the export consignments shall be inspected by Export Inspection Agencies (EIAs) or their Sub-Offices prior to dispatch. Under this system, representative samples would be drawn as per statistical sampling plan for inspection/testing to verify the conformity of the product to Turkish standards or to the requirements stipulated by the buyer in their export contracts. In the absence of any such standards, testing would be done as per the relevant National standards (BIS/AGMARK/PFA) for only the Health and Safety parameters of the product in addition to the buyer's requirements. In case, the exporting unit does not have adequate testing facilities, samples would be sent to the EIA laboratories or any NABL accredited lab in Government or Private Sector.

Note: In the case of pharmaceuticals, the lab that is specifically accredited by NABL for drugs to be approached.

- 4.1.2. Procedure:
 - 4.1.2.1. An exporter intending to export any of the listed food products and food packaging materials to Turkey shall submit an Application under CWI System in duplicate as per proforma given at Annex-I along with a bank draft of the requisite fee, copy of invoice/packing list and of the buyers' order to the Head Office/sub office of the Export Inspection Agency under whose jurisdiction the exporting unit is situated.
 - 4.1.2.2. The application for inspection under CWI System shall be submitted by the exporter to the concerned EIA two days in advance if the inspection is to be carried out at the premises situated at the same station of the office of Export Inspection Agency and five days in advance if the inspection is to be carried out at the premises which is not situated at the same station of the office of Export Inspection Agency.
 - 4.1.2.3. On receipt of the application, the concerned EIA would ensure that the necessary action on the same is taken by them within 48 hours.
 - 4.1.2.4. Fee will be charged @ 0.4% of f.o.b. value subject to minimum of Rs.1,000/- per consignment plus actual transportation cost plus the actual testing charges in case samples are sent to an outside lab.

4.2 IN-PROCESS QUALITY CONTROL (IPQC) SYSTEM SYSTEM/FOOD SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS BASED CERTIFICATION (FSMSC) SCHEME

4.2.1. Units approved under this system will be eligible to get Health Certificates for food products and food packaging materials meant for export to Turkey without further verification of their quality by EIAs. As per the existing norms, these units would be subject to periodical monitoring/supervisory visits by the EIAs. On the basis of the certificate of inspection issued by these approved units, Health Certificate would be issued by the concerned EIA.

- 4.2.2. Fee will be charged @ 0.2% of f.o.b. value subject to minimum of Rs.500/- per consignment for goods manufactured and exported by units approved under IPQC/FSMSC System.
- 4.2.3. For the purpose of assessing an unit under IPQC/FSMSC Scheme, the Agency Incharge would constitute a team of minimum two officials, atleast one of them being a subject specialist.

5. PACKING & LABELLING

The consignment intended for export to Turkey shall be packed in food grade packing material with following information given on cartons:

- 1. Name & address of the exporter
- 2. Variety & grade (if any)
- 3. Lot/Batch No.
- 4. Gross / Net weight
- 5. Country of Origin
- 6. Shipping Mark
- 7. Expiry date

6. FORMAT OF HEALTH CERTIFICATE

EIA or its sub-office shall issue the Health Certificate in the format placed at Annex-III after the consignment has been found meeting the relevant requirements.

7. VALIDITY OF HEALTH CERTIFICATE

The Health Certificate shall be valid for a period of 45 days from the date of its issuance.

8. ISSUE OF HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON RETROSPECTIVE BASIS

In case a unit being unaware of Turkish requirements of Health Certification has already shipped a consignment, Health Certificate may be issued as an exception on the basis of the test certificate issued by a Government lab. Alternately, inspection/testing may be conducted on the reference samples of the shipped lot preserved by the unit.

9. APPEAL

- 1. Any person aggrieved by the refusal of the Agency to issue a Health Certificate under Clause 8 may within 10 days of receipt of such communication may prefer an appeal to the Director, EIC.
- 2. The appeal shall be disposed off within 7 days of its receipt

10. RECORD MAINTENANCE

A separate record of Health Certificates issued for Turkey along with the inspection/ testing reports would be maintained each EIA and a monthly return in the format placed at Annex-III would be sent to EIC.
