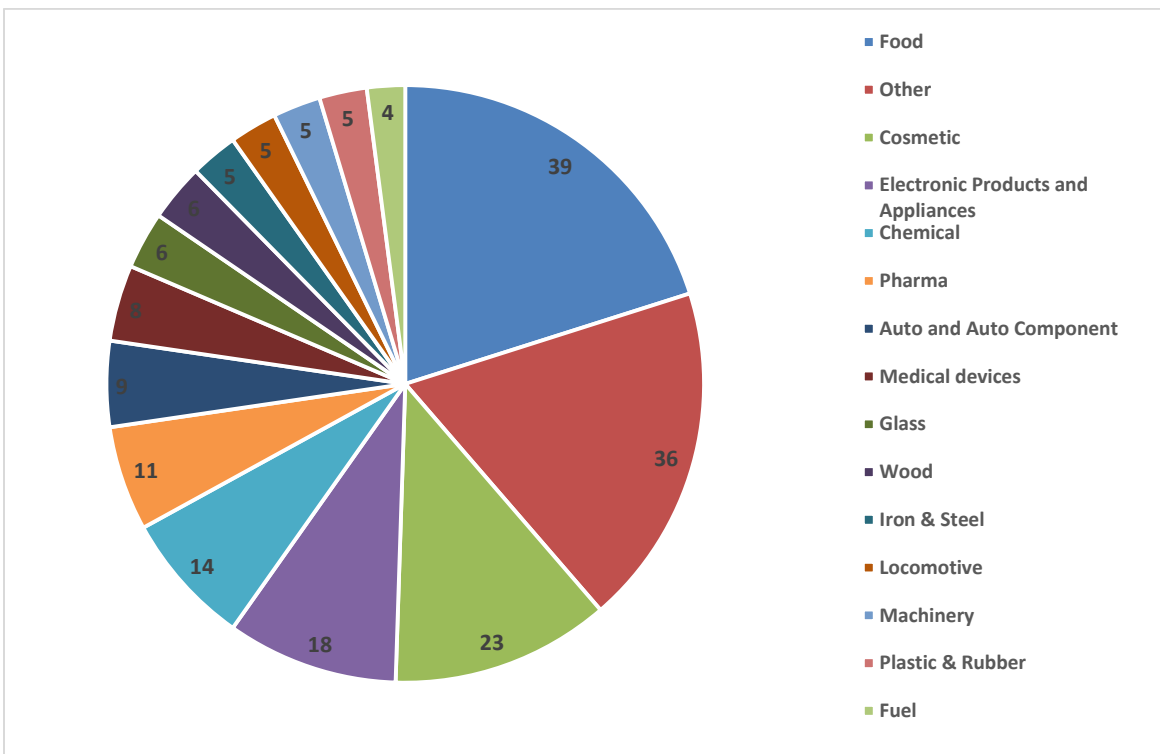
**TBT MONTHLY REPORT (JUNE 2019): AT A GLANCE**

**Details Pertaining to TBT Notifications Issued By WTO Member Countries**

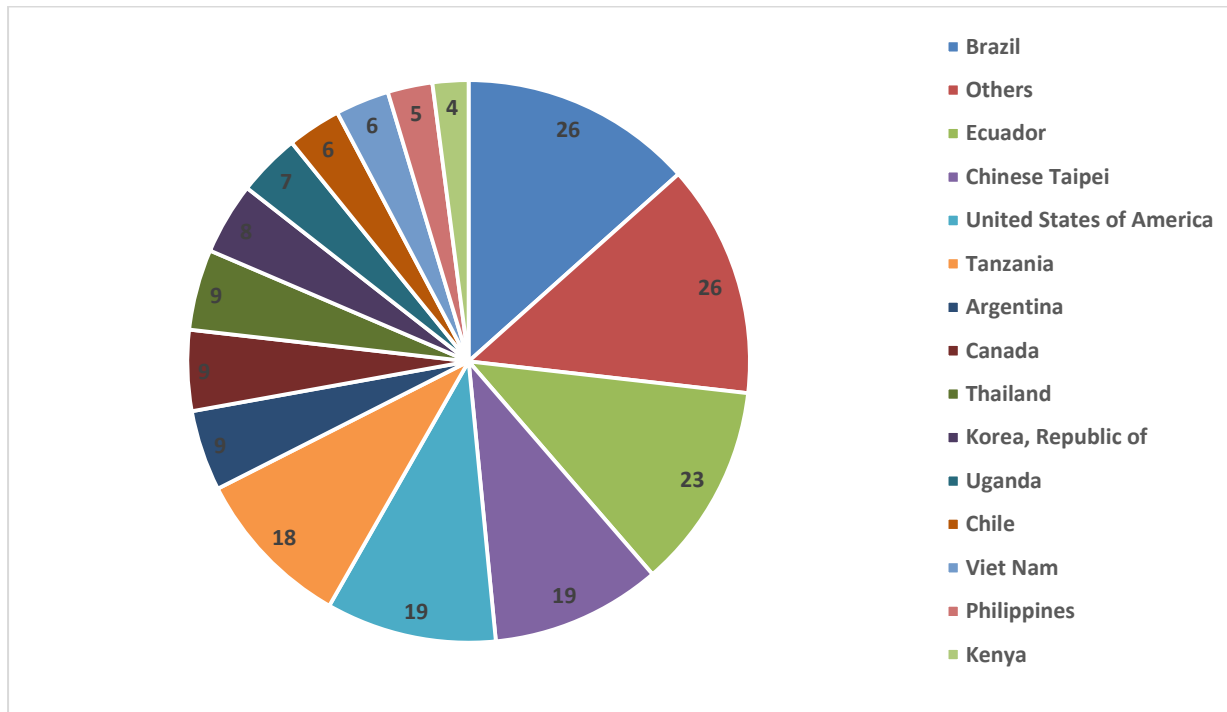
The total numbers of TBT Notifications issued by the various WTO-Member Countries in June 2019 were 195. Out of which, India has issued one notification. Hence, 194 notifications were studied in June 2019. Out of 194 notifications, 56 notifications were the addendum of draft regulations notified earlier in the WTO.

**Details Pertaining to TBT Notifications Relevant To India**

**Product-wise Information:** Out of the total 194 Notifications, 39 related to food, 23 were related to cosmetic, 18 related to electronic products and appliances, 14 related to chemical, 11 related to pharma, 9 related to auto and auto component, 8 related to medical devices, 6 related to glass products, 6 related to wood, 5 related to Iron & Steel, 5 related to locomotive, 5 related to machinery, 5 related to plastic & rubber, 4 related to fuel and 36 notifications were related to other products.



**Country-wise Information:** Out of the total 194 notifications, Brazil issued 26 notifications, followed by Ecuador, Chinese Taipei, USA, Tanzania, Argentina, Canada, Thailand, Korea, Uganda, Chile, Viet Nam, Philippines and Kenya with 23, 19, 19, 18, 9, 9, 9, 8, 7, 6, 6, 5 and 4 Notifications, respectively. The remaining 26 Notifications were from other WTO Member countries.



**TBT Notifications Relevant to India**

This section covers details of notifications which are relevant to India and where a letter has forwarded to all relevant and interested stakeholders seeking their comments on the notification. Stakeholders include individual exporters, organizations, associations and government departments representing the product mentioned in these notifications.

In June 2019, there were 194 notifications issued by WTO member countries which were relevant to India. Letters have already been sent to their respective stakeholders; however, the responses from the stakeholders are awaited. We are regularly following up on these notifications.
